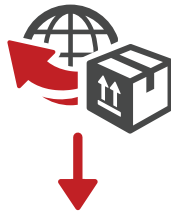


# Air Freight Clearances... how does it all work?

A package is sent from overseas to New Zealand  
The package arrives at the airline terminal



If goods are under \$60NZD then no tax is payable.

**HOORAY!**

Regardless of the value of the goods you require a customs broker to clear the goods through customs and quarantine;

Call **0800 166 716** for a quote

If goods are over \$60 NZD then duty and/or GST is payable



Platinum Freight<sup>®</sup> need 5 things to proceed (email to [info@platinumfreight.co.nz](mailto:info@platinumfreight.co.nz))

All importers require a New Zealand Customs Client Code (if goods value > \$400) • If goods are over NZ\$60.00 then Duty/GST is Payable

**SCENARIO 1**  
Customs Clearance and MPI (Ministry of Primary Industries) release received

You collect goods from the Airport OR Platinum Freight can deliver them to you



**SCENARIO 2**  
Shipment is released by Customs but NOT MPI (Ministry of Primary Industries)

Platinum Freight collect goods from the Airport and take to MPI for inspection

You collect goods from MPI depot OR Platinum Freight can deliver them to you



**SCENARIO 3**  
Shipment is NOT released by Customs OR MPI (Ministry of Primary Industries)

Customs inspection organised. Goods released

MPI inspection organised. Goods released

You collect goods from MPI depot OR Platinum Freight can deliver them to you
